Your child is interested in joining the Dungeons & Dragons Club at SMS. The D&D Club strives to create an enjoyable, safe, friendly, and memorable experience. The D&D club will meet Thursdays from 3:00-5:00 in cafeteria. The first meeting will be on October 2, 2023. The club will meet every Monday.

D&D is a fantasy roleplaying game that was first published in 1974, Wikipedia has an excellent overview of the game if you are interested in more information.

There are rules that help the game flow smoothly. Please review these rules with your child and sign the attached permission slip. We will be spending the first day discussing rules and procedures. If you have any questions, please contact: Ms. Fuentes.

If parents would like to join, please fill out the volunteer form with the district.

1. Character sheets will be done on paper, no electronic devices allowed.
2. Pay Attention - When the DM or GM is talking, when players are taking actions, when combat is raging pay attention.
3. Share the Spotlight - make a conscious effort to share the spotlight with other, quieter members of the group. you are not the main character of the story—your whole group is the main character.
4. Play Nice - Play nice! Both in and out of character.
5. Play Fair - Players should not cheat, even to save their characters' lives. There are ways to deal with bad rolls that do not force a player to stoop so low as to cheat.
6. Avoid Metagaming - Metagaming is when you use the knowledge that you have as a player (that your character does not) to make choices that your character would not otherwise make.
7. Do not Touch Other Players' Dice or other items.

Also, there are rules to D&D that will be explained on day 1 and to new players when they join.
