

Habitudes: Three Buckets

Three Buckets to help teach stress management. This lesson identifies behaviors effective leaders use in putting their tasks and responsibilities into one of three buckets: what is in their control, what is out of their control or what is within their influence. Once designated, their actions become clearer for each: initiate, trust or respond. Students will be challenged to think about our world to identify events or actions where the people involved (political figure, celebrity or public figure) may not have accurately identified which bucket the situation fell into.

Last night the Superintendent challenged those in attendance to compare the past to the present through an analogy of car factories: silent black and white film from a Model-T assembly line to today's modern Tesla assembly line. Participants were asked to note the critical points that crossed over between these two videos of American technology and the people working within their cutting-edge technology.
