What do I need to know before the week starts: 2/6-2/10

New Semester means...

For many students the change in semester can mean changes in their day. They may take a different course. They may have a different teacher. They may have classes in different periods of the day. What every student gets is a fresh start. No one will enter their classes with a grade, all students will be working to present their teachers evidence of their knowledge and skill over the next semester (with formal projection at the midpoint). How they will demonstrate their growth will vary greatly by class, grade level and individual student. Staff will give formal direction, present a spectrum of materials and offer both ongoing tasks and periodic assessments. The state or national standards in each course have identified targets that will serve as the point of comparison for teachers to match with collected student evidence. We believe every student that makes a consistent effort in any course will present evidence for our staff to note growth.

What we recommend this weekend to help with the transition

We suggest frank conversations about home expectations, effort put forth, persistence through challenge, and the habits you have seen at home over the first semester. From those conversations, besides cleaning out backpacks (strongly recommended) we encourage you to consider some changes to try in the upcoming semester. For many, this might be as simple as establishing a weekly check in on task completion connected to some rewards at home. If your student met both their own and home's expectations, congratulations and get ready for more success in the coming term.


